EXECUTIVE BRANCH ... Executes or carries out Article II

the Head of the Executive branch is the president

- •The president can <u>VETO</u> or reject a bill
- · State of the Union Speech
- · chooses <u>cabinet</u>
- appoints justicescan grant pardons

JUDICIAL BRANCH! interprets laws Article III headed by the Supreme Court with <u>9</u> judges Judges are appointed by the <u>President</u> and approved by the senate
